5 **WHEREAS**, the national debt of the United States is over \$5,000,000,000,000 and the 6 estimated share of the debt for each United States citizen is approximately \$20,000; and

7 WHEREAS, the national debt is increasing at an average of over \$700,000,000 each
8 day; and

9 WHEREAS, the accumulated debt of the United States represents a significant financial
10 burden for future generations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Fifty-fifth Legislative Assembly urges the Congress of the United States to
consider, and the President of the United States to support, an amendment to the Constitution
of the United States to require a balanced federal budget which guarantees protection of Social
Security trust funds and which excludes Social Security spending and revenues from budget
calculations as required by current law; and **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this
