1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study assessment and taxation of 2 mobile homes, park model trailers, recreational vehicles, and similar housing alternatives. 3 WHEREAS, questions have been raised by citizens about the equity of assessment and 4 taxation of mobile homes, park model trailers, recreational vehicles, and similar housing 5 alternatives; and 6 WHEREAS, available information indicates a lack of uniformity in assessment of mobile 7 homes, park model trailers, and similar housing alternatives; and 8 WHEREAS, recreational vehicles are generally not subject to ad valorem taxation but 9 may be used for the same purposes as housing alternatives that are subject to ad valorem 10 taxation; and 11 WHEREAS, changes in housing alternatives and their uses necessitate a thorough 12 review of law and assessment practices to assure equitable tax treatment for owners of such 13 property; 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 15 16 That the Legislative Council study the assessment and taxation of mobile homes, park model trailers, recreational vehicles, and similar housing alternatives; and 17
