- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 39-12 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to stopping at weigh stations; and to provide civil and criminal penalties.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 39-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Failure to stop at weigh station Penalty. A driver of a truck or truck tractor towing a
- 7 trailer whose truck and load or truck tractor, trailer, and load exceeds twenty-six thousand
- 8 pounds [11793.40 kilograms] or who is transporting hazardous materials shall immediately stop
- 9 at the nearest weigh station upon entering this state. A violation of this section is a class B
- 10 misdemeanor. In addition to the criminal penalty, the driver also is subject to a civil penalty not
- 11 to exceed one hundred dollars per mile past the nearest weigh station to the point of arrest.
- 12 The civil penalty may be imposed by the court in a civil proceeding or by the director through an
- 13 administrative hearing.
