HOUSE BILL NO. 1059 (Representative Keiser)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 15-38.1-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to compensation for members of the education factfinding commission.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-38.1-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

15-38.1-04. Compensation of commission and factfinders. Members of the commission shall are entitled to receive fifty compensation at the rate of sixty-two dollars and fifty cents per day for their attendance at regular or special and reimbursement for expenses, as provided by law for state officers, for attending commission meetings of or performing duties directed by the commission or in the performance of such special duties as the commission may direct. In addition to such compensation, they shall receive an allowance for actual and necessary travel and subsistence expenses while performing commission functions away from their places of residence.
