## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 49-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Services for the identification of telephone solicitors - Penalty. A telephone solicitor may not use any method, including per call blocking or per line blocking, that prevents caller identification information for the solicitor's lines used to make consumer telephone calls from being shown by a device capable of displaying caller identification information. The caller identification information displayed must contain a telephone number at which the telephone solicitor may receive telephone calls and the name of the telephone solicitor. The commission may collect an administrative penalty not to exceed one thousand dollars for each day or portion of a day from a telephone solicitor who has violated this section. In this section, "consumer telephone call" means an unsolicited call made to a residential telephone number to solicit a sale of a consumer good or service, to solicit an extension of credit for a consumer good or service, or to obtain information intended to be used to solicit a sale of a consumer good or service or to extend credit for the sale; and "telephone solicitor" means a person who makes or causes to be made a consumer telephone call.
