FIRST ENGROSSMENT with House Amendments

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-17 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to injuring another while fleeing a peace officer; and to amend and
- 3 reenact section 39-10-71 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the penalty for fleeing a
- 4 peace officer.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 12.1-17 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
 - Assault or homicide while fleeing peace officer. A person is guilty of a class A felony if that person negligently causes the death of another or a class B felony if that person negligently causes serious bodily injury to another while in violation of section 39-10-71.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 39-10-71 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - **39-10-71.** Fleeing or attempting to elude a peace officer <u>- Penalty</u>. Any driver of a motor vehicle who willfully fails or refuses to bring the vehicle to a stop, or who otherwise flees or attempts to elude, in any manner, a pursuing police vehicle or peace officer, when given a visual or audible signal to bring the vehicle to a stop, is guilty of a class A misdemeanor for a first or second offense and a class C felony for a subsequent offense. A signal complies with this section if the signal is perceptible to the driver and:
 - If given from a vehicle, the signal is given by hand, voice, emergency light, or siren, and the stopping vehicle is appropriately marked showing it to be an official police vehicle; or
- 22 2. If not given from a vehicle, the signal is given by hand, voice, emergency light, or siren, and the officer is in uniform and prominently displays the officer's badge of office.
