- 1 A BILL for an Act to require the posting and publishing of notices regarding permit applications
- 2 for confined animal feeding operations.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. Confined animal feeding operations - Notice of permit application.

- 1. Whenever an application is filed with any governmental entity for a permit related to the construction or renovation of a confined animal feeding operation, the governmental entity receiving the application shall:
 - a. Post notice of the completed application in the United States post office
 having the closest proximity to the site or proposed site, for a period of thirty
 days;
 - b. Post notice of the completed application in the building that serves as the seat of government for the county in which the site is located or in which the proposed site is to be located, for a period of thirty days; and
 - c. Publish notice of the completed application in the official newspaper of the county in which the site or the proposed site is located, at least once each week for four consecutive weeks.
- 2. The notice required by this section must include:
 - a. The name and address of each applicant and all primary capital investors:
 - A brief description of the planned operation or the changes to an existing operation;
 - A brief description of the administrative procedures to be followed, including the provision of a comment period, in reaching a final determination regarding issuance or denial of the permit;

1 d. The manner in which interested persons may provide comments for 2 consideration of the governmental entity; 3 The proposed date and time for a public hearing; and e. 4 f. The manner in which interested persons may obtain further information, 5 including a copy of the permit application, and any accompanying documents. 6 3. The applicant is responsible for any costs incurred by the governmental entity in 7 preparing, posting, and publishing notice of the application as required by this 8 section. 9 The governmental entity may not make a final determination on the issuance or 10 denial of the permit until thirty days have passed since the initial posting and initial 11 publication required by subsection 1. 12 This section applies to any confined animal feeding operation that requires an 5. 13 approval to operate from the state department of health.
