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4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 26.1-17-33.1 of the 1997 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision in this title or chapter 10-33, the board of directors of a nonprofit mutual insurance company consists of a majority of consumer members elected by the consumer members. Except for an incumbent consumer board member running for reelection, a consumer member seeking nomination as a candidate for consumer director shall submit a petition containing one hundred signatures of members on a petition form designated by the nonprofit mutual insurance company. The petition form must be available at least ninety days before an election. To be valid, a completed petition must be filed with the nonprofit mutual insurance company at least forty-five days before the election. The election must be conducted by mail and use of a proxy or a proxy committee is not allowed. Each consumer director's term must be at least three years unless election is to a vacant position, in which case the term of office is the unexpired portion of the term being filled. A consumer director may not serve more than three successive three-year terms.
