1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-01-18 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to location of game traps; and to provide a penalty.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-01-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **20.1-01-18. Hunting on posted land and trapping on ~~private~~ land without**
7 **permission unlawful - Penalty.** ~~No~~ A person may not hunt or pursue game, or enter for those
8 purposes, upon legally posted land belonging to another without first obtaining the permission
9 of the person legally entitled to grant the same. ~~No~~ A person may not enter upon ~~privately~~
10 ~~owned~~ land for the purpose of trapping protected fur-bearing animals without first gaining the
11 written permission of the owner or operator of that land and must provide a map to the owner or
12 operator of that land identifying the location of all traps placed on that land. A person who fails
13 to provide a map identifying the location of traps as provided in this section is guilty of an
14 infraction. A person who otherwise violates this section is guilty of a class B misdemeanor for
15 the first offense and a class A misdemeanor for a subsequent offense within a two-year period.
