- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-21-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, or
- 2 in the alternative to amend and reenact section 15.1-02-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 3 relating to qualifications for the superintendent of public instruction.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** If House Bill No. 1034 does not become effective, section 15-21-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 15-21-01. Superintendent of public instruction Qualifications Term of office.
- 8 There must be elected by the The qualified electors of the state, at the time of choosing
- 9 members of the legislative assembly, shall elect a superintendent of public instruction who must
- 10 have attained the age of at the appropriate general election. The superintendent must be at
- 11 least twenty-five years, who must of age on the day of the election and have the qualifications
- 12 of an elector for that office, and who must be the holder of a teacher's certificate of the highest
- 13 grade issued in this state. He shall have his office at the seat of government, and his term of
- 14 office is four years.
- 15 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-02-01 of the North Dakota Century Code as
- 16 created by House Bill No. 1034, as approved by the fifty-sixth legislative assembly, is amended
- 17 and reenacted as follows:
- 18 **15.1-02-01. Superintendent of public instruction Qualifications.** The qualified
- 19 electors of this state shall elect a superintendent of public instruction at the appropriate general
- 20 election. The superintendent must be at least twenty-five years of age on the day of the
- 21 election, and have the qualifications of an elector for that office, and hold a valid North Dakota
- 22 teaching certificate on the day of the election and at all times during the superintendent's term
- 23 of office.
