- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 29-08 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to bail as the defendant's property.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 29-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- Bail Defendant's property. Moneys deposited as bail are the property of the
 defendant, whether deposited by the defendant or by a third person on the defendant's behalf.
- 8 When moneys are accepted by the court as bail, the judge shall order that the moneys received
- 9 be deposited with the clerk of court. The clerk shall retain the moneys until the final order of the
- 10 court disposing of the case. Upon release of the moneys held by the clerk, the moneys must
- 11 be paid to the defendant or pursuant to the defendant's written direction. In the case of a
- 12 conviction, the judge may order the moneys to be applied to any fine, cost, or restitution
- imposed on the defendant. The balance of the deposit, if any, must be paid to the defendant.
- 14 Moneys deposited with the court or clerk of court as bail are exempt from garnishment,
- 15 attachment, or execution.
