- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 4-09-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to canola seed standards.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 4-09-10 of the 1997 Supplement 5 to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 6 1. a. In seeds of wheat, durum, barley, oats, rye, soybeans, dry beans, and flax the 7 commonly accepted name of the kind and variety of each agricultural seed 8 component in excess of five percent of the whole and the percentage by 9 weight of each. Variety identification is not required for seeds labeled "for 10 vegetative cover only". 11 In seeds of canola, seed must be certified by the commissioner as meeting b. 12 the standards of this chapter or have been certified by another state or 13 province having certification standards for canola which meet or exceed 14 standards adopted by this chapter. 15 <del>b.</del> с. In all other seeds not named in subdivision subdivisions a and b the 16 commonly accepted name of the kind or the kind and variety of each 17 agricultural seed component in excess of five percent of the whole and the 18 percentage of weight of each. 19 When more than ten percent of the whole consists of an aggregate of <del>c.</del> d. 20 agricultural seed components, each present in an amount not exceeding five 21 percent of the whole, each component in excess of one percent of the whole 22 must be named together with the percentage by weight of each. All 23 components must be listed in the order of their predominance. Where more

- than one component is named, the word "mixture", or the word "mixed", must
- 2 be shown conspicuously on the label.
