1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 11-11-17 and 24-06-14 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to the appointment of district overseer of highways for unorganized3 territory.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 11-11-17 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 11-11-17. Board of county commissioners may supervise the building or 8 repairing of roads, bridges, and property of the county - Compensation. Whenever the 9 board of county commissioners of any county is required by law to lay out, oversee, and 10 supervise the building or repairing of roads and bridges, including the appointment of a district 11 overseer of highways' duties in unorganized territory, or the building or repairing of any property 12 owned by the county, the board may appoint or designate one or more members of the board 13 personally to lay out, oversee, or supervise the building or repairing of any such roads, bridges, 14 or property. Each commissioner shall receive as compensation for services the sum of five 15 dollars per day and the mileage provided by law for members of the board of county 16 commissioners. 17 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 24-06-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 18 19 **24-06-14.** District overseer of highways. In unorganized territory, the board of county 20 commissioners shall appoint a district overseer of highways whose power and duties are the 21 same as in an organized township, and whose compensation must be fixed by the board of 22 county commissioners to be paid on presentation of a verified bill at the regular meeting of the 23 board of county commissioners. The board may, by resolution, appoint one or more of its
