# SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4017

- 1 A concurrent resolution for the amendment of section 5 of article V of the Constitution of North
- 2 Dakota, relating to the election of executive branch officers.

#### 3 STATEMENT OF INTENT

- 4 This amendment provides that one-half of the elected state officials will be chosen by voters in
- 5 each election year. To start this arrangement, the agriculture commissioner, attorney general,
- 6 secretary of state, and tax commissioner will be elected for two-year terms in 2004, and
- 7 thereafter will be elected to four-year terms.

#### 8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF

### 9 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

- That the following proposed amendment to section 5 of article V of the Constitution of
- 11 North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at
- 12 the primary election to be held in 2000, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the
- 13 Constitution of North Dakota.
- 14 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 5 of article V of the Constitution of North Dakota
- 15 is amended and reenacted as follows:
- **Section 5.** The qualified electors shall choose the elected state officials at a time
- 17 designated by the legislative assembly. The elected state officials shall serve until their
- 18 successors are duly qualified. Terms of office of the elected officials except the public service
- 19 <u>commissioners</u> are four years, except that <u>in 2004 the agriculture commissioner, attorney</u>
- 20 general, secretary of state, and tax commissioner are elected to a term of two years. The terms
- 21 of the public service commissioners are six years, so arranged that one of them is elected every
- 22 two years. The terms of the governor and lieutenant governor begin on December fifteenth
- 23 following their election.

## Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly

- 1 If two or more candidates for any executive office other than for governor and lieutenant
- 2 governor receive an equal and highest number of votes, the legislative assembly in joint
- 3 session shall choose one of them for the office.
