3 STATEMENT OF INTENT

4 This amendment would protect the right to hunt, trap, and fish.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE

6 SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

7 That the following proposed new section to article I of the Constitution of North Dakota

8 is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the general

9 election to be held in 2000, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of

10 North Dakota.

SECTION 1. A new section to article I of the Constitution of North Dakota is created
and enacted as follows:

Hunting, trapping, and fishing and the taking of game and fish are a valued part of our heritage and will be forever preserved for the people and managed by law and regulation for the public good.
