- 3 WHEREAS, farm families and rural communities are suffering an economic downturn
- 4 similar to the farm crisis of the 1980s; and
- 5 WHEREAS, farmers in this state and elsewhere have had to contend with prolonged
- 6 periods of disastrous weather and crop disease; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the 1996 farm bill replaced the previous system of farm income protection
- 8 with a set of fixed, but declining, payments unrelated to commodity prices and capped
- 9 commodity marketing loan rates; and
- 10 WHEREAS, providing for a cap on commodity marketing loan rates which would reflect
