## Legislative Assembly of North Dakota HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3065

1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the uses of funding provided to
2	the Children's Services Coordinating Committee.
3	WHEREAS, the Children's Services Coordinating Committee receives funding from
4	"refinancing," a system administered through the Department of Human Services which claims
5	federal reimbursement of certain administrative costs of local schools, juvenile courts, and
6	public health organizations under federal IV-E foster care and federal Medicaid programs; and
7	WHEREAS, twelve regional and tribal children's services coordinating committees
8	operate across the state to coordinate services to children in each region and Indian reservation
9	and to distribute grants to local service providers for children's programs; and
10	WHEREAS, a 1996 performance audit of the Children's Services Coordinating
11	Committee raised concerns regarding the level of administrative costs of the regional and tribal
12	children's services coordinating committees; and
13	WHEREAS, the 1997 Legislative Assembly made changes to limit administrative costs
14	of these committees; and
15	WHEREAS, the "refinancing" funds generated for the 1997-99 biennium are estimated
16	to total \$8,000,000;
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
18	OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
19	That the Legislative Council study the uses of funds appropriated to the Children's
20	Services Coordinating Committee; and
21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the study include a review of the use of funding
22	received by the regional and tribal children's services coordinating committees and the
23	appropriate level of administrative costs for these committees; and

- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the study include a review of the entities involved in generating the "refinancing" funds and how the "refinancing" funding returned to them is being used; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly.
