1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability
2	of consolidating under the School for the Blind all programs and services provided to children
3	and adults who are blind or visually impaired.
4	WHEREAS, the state has a significant interest in ensuring that children and adults who
5	are blind or visually impaired are able to function as independently as possible; and
6	WHEREAS, children and adults who are blind or visually impaired require a continuum
7	of educational, rehabilitative, and other services or assistance if they are to function as
8	independently as possible; and
9	WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the state to make available an appropriate
10	continuum of services to children and adults who are blind or visually impaired; and
11	WHEREAS, the state offers a variety of services to children and adults who are blind or
12	visually impaired through the School for the Blind and the Vocational Rehabilitation Division of
13	the Department of Human Services;
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
15	HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
16	That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of consolidating under
17	the School for the Blind all programs and services provided to children and adults who are blind
18	or visually impaired; and
19	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
20	recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
21	the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly.
