HOUSE BILL NO. 1015

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state industrial

2 commission and the agencies under the management of the state industrial commission; to

3 provide a continuing appropriation; to authorize transfers; and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 6 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in 7 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal 8 funds and other income, to the state industrial commission and agencies under its control for 9 the purpose of defraying the expenses of their various divisions, for the biennium beginning 10 July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, as follows:

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. In addition to the amount appropriated to the housing
 finance agency in subdivision 5 of section 1 of this Act, there is hereby appropriated any
 additional income or unanticipated income from federal or other funds that may become
 available to the agency for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.

5 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - EMERGENCY COMMISSION APPROVAL. In 6 addition to the amount appropriated to the industrial commission in subdivision 1 of section 1 of 7 this Act, there is hereby appropriated, with the approval of the emergency commission, funds 8 that may become available to the commission from bonds authorized by law to be issued by the 9 industrial commission under chapters 4-36 and 54-17.3 and section 54-17-25, for the biennium 10 beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.

SECTION 4. TRANSFER. The sum of \$66,473, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, included in the special funds appropriation line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, is from the North Dakota mill and elevator association. The moneys must be transferred during the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, upon order of the industrial commission.

16 SECTION 5. TRANSFER. The sum of \$86,706, or so much of the sum as may be 17 necessary, included in the special funds appropriation line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of 18 this Act, is from the accumulated and undivided profits of the Bank of North Dakota. The 19 moneys must be transferred during the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, upon order of the industrial commission.

SECTION 6. TRANSFER. The sum of \$57,803, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, included in the special funds appropriation line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, is from the housing finance agency fund. The moneys must be transferred during the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, upon order of the industrial commission.

SECTION 7. TRANSFER. The sum of \$20,231, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, included in the special funds appropriation line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, is from the revenues of the municipal bond bank. The available moneys must be transferred during the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, upon order of the industrial commission.

1 SECTION 8. INCOME AUTHORIZATION - STUDENT LOAN TRUST. There is hereby 2 authorized the receipt of fees by the industrial commission in the sum of \$66,675, or so much of 3 the sum as is owed, included in the special funds appropriation line item in subdivision 1 of 4 section 1 of this Act, from the student loan trust for administrative services rendered by the 5 industrial commission to the extent permitted by sections 54-17-24 and 54-17-25. The fees 6 must be received during the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, upon 7 order of the industrial commission.

8 SECTION 9. TRANSFER. The industrial commission shall transfer to the general fund 9 in the state treasury, the sum of \$3,000,000 from the North Dakota mill and elevator 10 association. The moneys must be transferred in amounts and at such times as requested by 11 the director of the office of management and budget during the biennium beginning July 1, 12 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.

13 SECTION 10. LIGNITE RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT, AND MARKETING

14 **PROGRAM - APPROPRIATION - LIGNITE MARKETING FEASIBILITY STUDY.** The amount 15 of \$500,000, or so much of the amount as may be necessary, included in the grants and special 16 funds appropriation line items in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, is from the lignite 17 research fund for the purpose of contracting for an independent, nonmatching lignite marketing 18 feasibility study or studies that determine those focused priority areas where near-term, 19 market-driven projects, activities, or processes will generate matching private industry 20 investment and have the most potential of preserving existing lignite production and jobs or that 21 will lead to increased development of lignite and its products and create new jobs and economic 22 growth for the general welfare of this state. Moneys appropriated pursuant to this section may 23 also be used for the purpose of contracting for nonmatching environmental studies and 24 activities, and studies and activities that assist with marketing of lignite-based electricity, and 25 lignite-based byproducts. Moneys not needed for the purposes stated herein are available to 26 the commission for funding projects, processes, or activities under the lignite research, 27 development, and marketing program.

SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - LEASE PAYMENTS. The amount of
\$15,891,168 included in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act in the bond payments line item
must be paid from the following funding sources during the biennium beginning July 1, 1999,
and ending June 30, 2001:

7 **SECTION 12. APPROPRIATION - TRANSFER.** The funds appropriated by 8 subdivision 3 of section 1 of this Act must be transferred by the Bank of North Dakota to the 9 partnership in assisting community expansion fund established by section 6-09.14-02; the 10 agricultural partnership in assisting community expansion fund established by section 11 6-09.13-04; and the beginning farmer loan fund established by section 6-09-15.5, unless the 12 beginning farmer loan fund is consolidated into the Bank of North Dakota, in the amounts set 13 out in that subdivision. The Bank of North Dakota may not be construed to be a general fund 14 agency because of the appropriation made by subdivision 3 of section 1 of this Act. 15 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY. The appropriation in subdivision 3 of section 1 and the

transfer in section 12 of this Act for the partnership in assisting community expansion fund are
 declared to be an emergency measure.
