- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the attorney general;
- 2 to provide statements of legislative intent; and to amend and reenact section 54-12-11 of the
- 3 North Dakota Century Code, relating to the salary of the attorney general.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided	I in this section, or so much of the
6	funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in	
7	the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal	
8	funds and other income, to the attorney general for the purpose of defraying the expenses of	
9	the attorney general, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, as	
10	follows:

I	SECTION 2. FIRE AND TORNADO FUND. The estimated income line item in
2	section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$385,517, or so much of the sum as may be
3	necessary, from the state fire and tornado fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses
4	related to the state fire marshal program.
5	SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - STATE FIRE MARSHAL PROGRAM. It is the
6	intent of the legislative assembly that the attorney general charge and collect a fee for services
7	provided by the state fire marshal program to entities not insured by the fire and tornado fund.
3	Fees collected for these services must be deposited in the general fund. For services provided
9	to entities insured by the fire and tornado fund, the attorney general is to prepare and submit a
10	memorandum billing to the fire and tornado fund. For the purpose of this section a
11	"memorandum billing" means a document detailing services and cost of services provided. The
12	memorandum billing does not require a remittance of funds from the fire and tornado fund.
13	SECTION 4. ASSET FORFEITURE FUND. The sum of \$74,201 is available from the
14	asset forfeiture fund to the attorney general as included in the estimated income line item in
15	section 1 of this Act.
16	SECTION 5. LOCAL GAMING ENFORCEMENT GRANTS. The grants line item in
17	section 1 of this Act includes \$221,877 for local gaming enforcement grants.
18	SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - LOCAL GAMING ENFORCEMENT GRANTS.
19	It is the intent of the legislative assembly that the attorney general, through the state treasurer's
20	office, disburse local gaming enforcement grants based on a competitive basis in accordance
21	with criteria established by the attorney general.
22	SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - LITIGATION FEES - EMERGENCY
23	COMMISSION REQUEST. It is the intent of the legislative assembly that the attorney general
24	submit a request to the emergency commission for an additional appropriation for litigation fees
25	from the contingency fund if the \$50,000 appropriated in the litigation fees line item in section 1
26	of this Act is exhausted.
27	SECTION 8. AMENDMENT. Section 54-12-11 of the 1997 Supplement to the North
28	Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
29	54-12-11. Salary of attorney general. The annual salary of the attorney general is
30	sixty-two sixty-eight thousand five three hundred ninety-two eighty-eight dollars through

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- 1 June 30, 1998 <u>2000</u>, and sixty four <u>seventy</u> thousand four hundred <u>sixty-four</u> <u>forty</u> dollars
- 2 thereafter.
