1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the public service

2 commission; and to amend and reenact section 49-01-05 and subsection 3 of section 49-21-01

3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the salary of public service commissioners and

4 the definition of essential telecommunications service.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 7 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in 8 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal 9 funds and other income, to the public service commission for the purpose of defraying the 10 expenses of the public service commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and 11 ending June 30, 2001, as follows: 12 \$4,383,989 Salaries and wages 13 **Operating expenses** 1,054,694 14 71,311 Equipment 15 Grants 6,000 16 AML contractual services 3,668,492 17 Total all funds \$9,184,486 18 Less estimated income 5,663,045 19 Total general fund appropriation \$3,521,441

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 49-01-05 of the 1997 Supplement to the North
