1 A BILL for an Act to make an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state game and

2 fish department.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 5 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the game and fish 6 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from 7 federal funds and other income, to the state game and fish department for the purpose of 8 defraying the expenses of the various divisions of the department, for the biennium beginning 9 July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, as follows: 10 Salaries and wages \$12,218,261 11 Operating expenses 7,779,014 12 Equipment 771,505 13 Capital improvements 1,602,122 14 Grants 3,397,050 15 Noxious weed control 200,000 16 Land habitat and deer depredation 2,703,224 17 Grants, gifts, and donations 100,000 18 Nongame wildlife conservation 120,000 19 200,000 Waterbank program 20 Lonetree reservoir 1,314,860 21 Total special funds appropriation \$30,406,036

SECTION 2. LAND HABITAT AND DEER DEPREDATION. The amount of
\$2,500,000, or such lesser amount as may be available, for the line item entitled land habitat
and deer depredation in section 1 of this Act, is from the habitat and depredation fund, to lease

privately owned lands for wildlife habitat to reestablish wildlife population, to improve wildlife
habitat on private lands, and to alleviate big game and furbearer depredation for the biennium
beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001. These funds may be spent only for the
purposes and using the guidelines contained in sections 20.1-03-12.1 and 20.1-02-05.

5 SECTION 3. NONGAME WILDLIFE. The amount of \$60,000, or such lesser amount 6 as may be available, for the line item entitled nongame wildlife in section 1 of this Act, is from 7 the nongame wildlife fund for the purpose of preservation, inventory, perpetuation, and 8 conservation of nongame wildlife, natural areas, and nature preserves in this state for the 9 biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.

10 SECTION 4. WATERBANK PROGRAM. The amount of \$200,000, or such lesser 11 amount as may be available, for the line item entitled waterbank program in section 1 of this 12 Act, is from the game and fish department operating fund and must be used to increase water 13 storage and enhance wildlife habitat in North Dakota. Priority must be given to contracts to 14 increase upper basin storage and enhance wildlife habitat in the Devils Lake basin. Contracts 15 and agreements relating to the waterbank program may be entered into by the director of the 16 game and fish department, in cooperation with the commissioner of agriculture.
