1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state water

2 commission; and to provide for a study by the state engineer of the feasibility and desirability of

3 constructing dams and other impoundments in the Pembina River watershed.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 6 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in 7 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal 8 funds and other income, to the various divisions of the state water commission for the purpose 9 of defraying the expenses of the various divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, as follows: 10 11 \$8,048,657 Salaries and wages 12 Operating expenses 6 050 687

SECTION 2. RESOURCES TRUST FUND. The amount of \$11,547,104, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, included in the estimated income line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act is from the resources trust fund for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001. SECTION 3. ALLOCATION OF GRANT FUNDS. The funds appropriated in the grants
 line item in section 1 of this Act must be disbursed by the state water commission in
 accordance with section 61-02-64.1.

SECTION 4. GRANTS. Section 54-44.1-11 does not apply to appropriations made for
grants in this Act. However, this exclusion is only in effect for two years after June 30, 2001.
Any unexpended funds after that period has expired must be transferred to the resources trust
fund.

8 SECTION 5. RESOURCES TRUST FUND APPROPRIATION - ADJUSTMENT. If the 9 resources trust fund 1999-2001 revenues are in excess of \$11,547,104, any excess is hereby 10 appropriated, subject to emergency commission approval, from the resources trust fund to the 11 state water commission for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001. 12 SECTION 6. STATE ENGINEER TO STUDY FEASIBILITY AND DESIRABILITY OF 13 CONSTRUCTING DAMS AND OTHER IMPOUNDMENTS IN THE PEMBINA RIVER 14 **WATERSHED.** The legislative assembly finds that floodwater in recent years has inundated 15 parts of the cities of Neche and Pembina, and thousands of acres of farmland along the 16 Pembina River in Pembina County. Construction of flood control dams and other 17 impoundments in the Pembina River watershed in the United States and Canada may reduce 18 flows on the Pembina River that may result in less severe flooding of the cities and farmland 19 along the lower reaches of the Pembina River. Therefore, within the limits of available funds, 20 the state engineer shall conduct a comprehensive study of the feasibility and desirability of 21 constructing dams and other impoundments in the Pembina River watershed for the purpose of 22 reducing flows in the lower reaches of the Pembina River. The state engineer shall submit a 23 report to an appropriate interim committee designated by the legislative council.
