ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2075

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 15-36-08, 15-38-18, 15-38-18.2, and 15-41-25
- 2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to provisional teaching certificates, application fees,
- 3 and education standards and practices board equivalency endorsements; and to declare an
- 4 emergency.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15-36-08 of the 1997 Supplement to the North
- 7 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 **15-36-08. Fees for certificates.** The education standards and practices board must
- 9 determine a fee for each certificate issued by this state, and no. Except for provisional
- 10 teaching certificates which are valid for sixty days and issued pursuant to rules adopted by the
- 11 board, a certificate may not be issued for a period of less than one school year. The fees must
- 12 be deposited and disbursed in accordance with section 54-44-12.
- 13 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 15-38-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 14 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 15 **15-38-18. Duties of the education standards and practices board.** It is the duty of
- 16 the board to supervise the certification of teachers; to set standards for and approve teacher
- 17 preparation programs; to issue minor equivalency endorsements; to develop and revise,
- 18 consistent with state law, professional codes or standards relating to ethics, conduct, and
- 19 professional performance and practices; and to provide recommendations for in-service
- 20 education of persons engaged in the profession of teaching in the public schools. In the
- 21 development of professional codes and standards, the board shall solicit the assistance of
- 22 members of the teaching profession and representatives of school administrators, school board
- 23 members, teacher education professors, and other interested citizens. The board shall adopt
- 24 approved or revised codes and standards as rules in accordance with chapter 28-32. The

- 1 board may enter into agreements with other states to acquire reciprocal approval of teacher
- 2 preparation programs, apply for and receive federal or other funds on behalf of the state for
- 3 purposes related to its duties, and to perform any other duty that relates to the improvement of
- 4 instruction through teacher education, professional development, and continuing education
- 5 programs. The board has the powers and privileges of a corporation, including the right to sue
- 6 and be sued in its own name as the board. The venue of all actions in which the board is a
- 7 party must be Burleigh County, North Dakota. The board shall appoint an executive director to
- 8 serve at its discretion. The executive director shall perform the duties assigned by the board.
- 9 The board shall authorize the employment of staff necessary for the sound and economic
- 10 administration of its duties, responsibilities, and functions. The executive director shall hire the
- 11 staff, subject to the approval of the board.
- 12 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Section 15-38-18.2 of the 1997 Supplement to the North
- 13 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 14 15-38-18.2. Education standards and practices board Initial certification of
- 15 **teachers Application fee Background.** The education standards and practices board may
- 16 charge an application fee established by the board by rule. The education standards and
- 17 practices board shall check, or cause to be checked, the background of each applicant for initial
- 18 certification as a teacher. The board shall require each applicant for certification to file a
- 19 complete set of the applicant's fingerprints, taken by a law enforcement officer, and all other
- 20 information necessary to complete a state and nationwide criminal history check with the
- 21 bureau of criminal investigation for state processing and filing with the federal bureau of
- 22 investigation for federal processing. All costs associated with the background check and with
- 23 obtaining and processing the fingerprints are the responsibility of the applicant. Criminal history
- 24 records provided to the board pursuant to this section are confidential and closed to the public
- and may only be used by the board for determining an applicant's eligibility for licensure and
- 26 obtaining documentation to support a denial of licensure. The board may adopt by rule,
- 27 procedures for issuing sixty-day provisional teaching certificates to applicants for initial
- 28 licensure pending completion of the background check. An applicant for a provisional teaching
- 29 certificate may be charged a fee established by the board by rule.
- 30 **SECTION 4. AMENDMENT.** Section 15-41-25 of the 1997 Supplement to the North
- 31 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 1 **15-41-25. High schools Teacher qualification.** Except as provided in section
- 2 15-29-08.4, every teacher in any high school in this state teaching any of the course areas or
- 3 fields mentioned in section 15-41-24 shall must have a valid teacher's certificate and shall must
- 4 have a major or minor <u>or a minor equivalency endorsement issued by the education standards</u>
- 5 <u>and practices board</u> in the course areas or fields that the teacher is teaching if the high school
- 6 is to receive any approval by the department of public instruction. However, a teacher granted
- 7 a certificate to teach in the disciplines of trade, industrial, technical, and or health under chapter
- 8 15-20.1 and possessing neither a major nor a minor in the field in which the teacher is
- 9 employed may not affect the approval of the employing school district.
- 10 **SECTION 5. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
