4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-44.3-20 of the 1997 Supplement to the North 6 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 54-44.3-20. Categories of positions in the state service. All positions in the state
 service are included in the classified service except:
 - Each official elected by popular vote and each person appointed to fill vacancies in an elective office, one principal assistant, and one private secretary.
 - Members of boards and commissions required by law.
 - Administrative heads of departments required by law, other than the superintendent of the school for the blind, the superintendent of the school for the deaf, and the state librarian.
- Officers and employees of the legislative branch of government.
- Members of the judicial branch of government of the state of North Dakota and
 their employees and jurors.
 - Persons temporarily employed in a professional or scientific capacity as
 consultants or to conduct a temporary and special inquiry, investigation, or
 examination for the legislative branch of government or a department of the state
 government.
- 7. Officers and members of the teaching staff of universities and other institutions of higher education.

- Positions deemed to be inappropriate to the classified service due to the special nature of the position as determined by the division and approved by the board.
- 9. 8. The classified employees at Employees of the institutions of higher education
 under the control of the state board of higher education, until July 1, 1976.

- 6 11. 10. Officers and employees of the North Dakota mill and elevator association.
