- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-36 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to provisional teaching certificates.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-36 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
 - 1. The education standards and practices board may issue provisional certification:
 - a. To an individual who has applied for a teaching certificate if, on or after August fifteenth, the superintendent of a school district that intends to hire the individual as a teacher files a petition for provisional certification with the education standards and practices board; and
 - b. To an individual whose teaching certificate expires during the school year, if the individual is not covered by those provisions of section 15-36-12 which relate to the expiration of a teaching certificate.
 - 2. Under provisional certification, an individual may perform all duties otherwise performed by a certificated teacher.
 - 3. Provisional certification is valid for thirty instructional days, beginning with the first instructional day after the date of issuance.
- If an individual is denied a teaching certificate within the period of provisional
 certification, the provisional certification is immediately revoked.
