BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 18-05-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - **18-05-06.** Service pension Who may receive Recipient entitled to no further relief from association. A firemen's firefighters relief association organized under the laws of this state may pay out of any funds received from the state, city, municipality, or from any other source a service pension in such an amount, not exceeding two hundred dollars per month, as may be provided by its the association's bylaws, to each of its members who has retired and who:
 - 1. Has reached the age of fifty years;
 - 2. Has done active duty for twenty years or more as a member of a volunteer, paid, or partially paid and partially volunteer, fire department or as an emergency medical technician, emergency care technician, or person holding an advanced first-aid ambulance certification in the municipality in which such the association exists;
 - Has been a member of the firemen's firefighters relief association or has been an
 emergency medical technician, emergency care technician, or held an advanced
 first-aid ambulance certificate for at least ten years prior to before the date of the
 person's retirement; and
 - 4. Complies with any additional conditions as to age, service, and membership which that may be prescribed by the bylaws of the association.

- 1 No A pension may not be paid to any person individual while the person that individual remains 2 a member of the fire department or an active emergency medical technician, emergency care
- 3 <u>technician, or person holding an advanced first-aid ambulance certification,</u> and a person an
- 4 <u>individual</u> who is receiving a service pension is entitled to no other relief from the association.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 18-05-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

18-05-07. Eligibility for service pension may be acquired by paying back assessments. Any A firefighter or emergency medical technician, emergency care technician, or person holding an advanced first-aid ambulance certification who, for the number of years required for retirement, actually has served in a fire department or as an emergency medical technician, emergency care technician, or held an advanced first-aid ambulance certificate in a municipality in which a firemen's firefighters relief association has been organized and who pays into the firemen's firefighters relief and pension fund maintained in such the municipality assessments equal to the amounts assessed against the members of the association during the time of the person's individual's service in the department, with interest upon such the assessments, must be allowed membership in the association and shall is entitled to receive, upon retirement, the same pension from the fund as is paid to other firefighters or emergency medical technician, emergency care technician, or person holding an advanced first-aid ambulance certification. The bylaws of an association may not contain any provision which that discriminates against a firefighter an individual who actually has worked as such a firefighter or emergency medical technician, emergency care technician, or person holding an advanced first-aid ambulance certification during the number of years required by the bylaws or which prevents the person individual from, or discriminates against the person individual in, participating in the association or in the benefits from the fund. The rights provided for in this chapter are acquired by compliance with this section whether such compliance was accomplished prior before or subsequent to after July 1, 1935, without regard to the time when the required service was performed.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 18-05-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

18-05-10. Qualifications as to age and term of service inapplicable to pension for disability. The qualifications as to age and term of service prescribed by this chapter do not

- 1 apply to a member of a fire department or an emergency medical technician, emergency care
- 2 <u>technician</u>, or person holding an advanced first-aid ambulance certification who makes an
- 3 application for a pension on account of injuries or disabilities which make the person results in
- 4 the individual being unfit for to perform the duties of an active firefighter or an emergency
- 5 medical technician, emergency care technician, or person holding an advanced first-aid
- 6 ambulance certification. The relief association shall pay the pension to such those members,
- 7 or to the widow or orphans surviving spouse or children of a deceased firefighter or emergency
- 8 medical technician, emergency care technician, or person holding an advanced first-aid
- 9 <u>ambulance certification</u>, in such the amounts and under such the limitations and conditions as
- 10 its articles of incorporation and bylaws provide and permit. No A pension paid to any one
- 11 family, however, may <u>not</u> exceed the maximum monthly service pension permitted under this
- 12 chapter.
