- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 6-09.10-03 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to an expiration date for the agricultural mediation service; and to declare an
- 3 emergency.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 6-09.10-03 of the 1997 Supplement to the North 6 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 6-09.10-03. North Dakota agricultural mediation service Powers Compensation
- 8 and expenses Fees. The board shall meet at the call of the chair, as is necessary to fulfill its
- 9 duties under this chapter. The department of agriculture commissioner shall administer the
- 10 agricultural mediation service. The commissioner of agriculture shall establish an agricultural
- 11 mediation service to disseminate information to farmers concerning farm credit problems and to
- 12 provide assistance to seek to resolve farm credit problems. The commissioner shall appoint an
- 13 administrator of the agricultural mediation service. The commissioner shall hire staff,
- 14 negotiators, and mediators who may mediate disputes involving farmers and others, either of
- 15 whom may request assistance. The board may charge the farmer and others a reasonable fee
- 16 for any assistance, provided, such funds to be the fees are used to continue the service until
- 17 June 30, <del>1999</del> 2001. Fees charged to the farmer's creditors are limited to twenty-five dollars
- 18 per hour, each, for the time spent in mediation sessions. The board shall adopt policies
- 19 governing the negotiators, staff, and mediators hired under this section. Board members are
- 20 entitled to receive sixty-five dollars for each day of official service, as directed by the board.
- 21 The board members are entitled to expenses as provided in sections 44-08-04 and 54-06-09.
- 22 The expenses provided under this section may be paid from any funds available in the
- 23 home-quarter purchase fund.
- 24 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
