1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state treasurer;

2 and to amend and reenact section 54-11-13 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the

3 salary of the state treasurer.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 6 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in 7 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the state treasurer for the purpose of 8 defraying the expenses of the state treasurer, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and 9 ending June 30, 2001, as follows: 10 Salaries and wages \$603,242 95,079 11 **Operating expenses** 12 Equipment 4,000 13 Total general fund appropriation \$702,321

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 54-11-13 of the 1997 Supplement to the North
Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

54-11-13. Salary of state treasurer. The annual salary of the state treasurer is
fifty-five sixty thousand four six hundred sixty-four dollars through June 30, 1998 2000, and
fifty-seven sixty-two thousand one four hundred twenty twenty-four dollars thereafter.
