- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the insurance
- 2 commissioner; to amend and reenact sections 26.1-01-09 and 26.1-23-03 of the North Dakota
- 3 Century Code, relating to the salary of the insurance commissioner and the unsatisfied
- 4 judgment fund; and to provide for a legislative council study.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 7 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the insurance 8 regulatory trust fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from other special 9 funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the insurance commissioner for the 10 purpose of defraying the expenses of the insurance commissioner, for the biennium beginning 11 July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, as follows: 12 \$4,195,649 Salaries and wages 13 Operating expenses 1,503,289

14 Equipment 153,155

15 Total special funds appropriation \$5,852,093

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - INSURANCE TAX PAYMENTS TO FIRE

17 **DEPARTMENTS.** There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the insurance tax

18 distribution fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$5,200,000, or so

19 much of the sum as may be necessary, to the commissioner of insurance for the purpose of

20 making payments of insurance premiums to fire departments for the biennium beginning July 1,

21 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.

> **SECTION 3. BONDING FUND.** Section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$67,431, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the state bonding fund to pay bonding fund

24 administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.

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1 SECTION 4. FIRE AND TORNADO FUND. Section 1 of this Act includes the sum of 2 \$831,145, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the state fire and tornado fund to 3 pay fire and tornado fund administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and 4 ending June 30, 2001. 5 SECTION 5. UNSATISFIED JUDGMENT FUND. Section 1 of this Act includes the 6 sum of \$4,170, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the state unsatisfied 7 judgment fund to pay unsatisfied judgment fund administrative expenses for the biennium 8 beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001. 9 SECTION 6. PETROLEUM TANK RELEASE COMPENSATION FUND. Section 1 of 10 this Act includes the sum of \$68,820, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the 11 petroleum tank release compensation fund to pay petroleum tank release compensation fund 12 administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001. 13 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY. The legislative council shall consider 14 studying, during the 1999-2000 interim, the activities of and the need for continuing the 15 petroleum tank release compensation fund. 16 SECTION 8. AMENDMENT. Section 26.1-01-09 of the 1997 Supplement to the North 17 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 18 **26.1-01-09.** Salary of commissioner. The annual salary of the commissioner is 19 fifty five fifty-eight thousand four two hundred eighty-seven sixty-two dollars through June 30, 20 4998 2000, fifty-nine thousand four hundred twenty-eight dollars through December 31, 2000, 21 and fifty-seven sixty-two thousand ene eight hundred twenty fifty-five dollars thereafter. 22 **SECTION 9. AMENDMENT.** Section 26.1-23-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is 23 amended and reenacted as follows: 24 26.1-23-03. Additional registration fee - Deposit in fund - Suspension of fee. At 25 the time of registering a motor vehicle, the owner shall pay to the director of the department of 26 transportation, in addition to the registration fees, a fee of one dollar for each motor vehicle 27 registered. The fees must be deposited with the state treasurer who shall credit the fees to the 28 unsatisfied judgment fund. If on June first of any year the amount of uncommitted money in the 29 fund is three hundred one hundred fifty thousand dollars or more, the requirement for the 30 payment of the fee is suspended during the succeeding year and until the year in which the fee

is reimposed. The fee must be reimposed for any year whenever on June first of the previous

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- 1 year the uncommitted amount of the fund is less than three hundred one hundred fifty thousand
- 2 dollars.
