## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 6 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in 7 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal 8 funds and from other income, to the state historical society for the purpose of defraying the 9 expenses of the state historical society, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending 10 June 30, 2001, as follows: 11 \$4,299,169 Salaries and wages 12 908,323 Operating expenses 13 81,244 Equipment 14 Capital improvements 782,735 15 Grants 485,559 Yellowstone-Missouri-Fort Union Commission 16 4,727 17 Lewis and Clark bicentennial 641,345 18 Total all funds \$7,203,102 19 Less estimated income 1,032,438

8 emergency measure.
