1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state historical
2 society; to provide for line item transfers for the 1997-99 biennium; and to declare an
3 emergency.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
6 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in
7 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal
8 funds and from other income, to the state historical society for the purpose of defraying the
9 expenses of the state historical society, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending
10 June 30, 2001, as follows:

21 **SECTION 2. LINE ITEM TRANSFERS - 1997-99 BIENNIUM.** Notwithstanding section
22 54-16-04, the director of the office of management and budget and the state treasurer, at the
23 request of the superintendent of the state historical society, shall transfer \$34,886 from the
24 equipment line item contained in subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 22 of the 1997 Session

1 Laws to the operating expenses line item contained in subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 22
2 of the 1997 Session Laws. The authority to make this transfer begins with the effective date of
3 this Act and ends on June 30, 1999.

4 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION.** There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$4,900 of
5 federal funds available to the state historical society for the purpose of purchasing equipment
6 for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 1999.

7 **SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** Sections 2 and 3 of this Act are declared to be an
8 emergency measure.
