

**FIRST ENGROSSMENT  
with Conference Committee Amendments****ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2020**

Introduced by

Appropriations Committee

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state historical  
2 society; to provide for line item transfers for the 1997-99 biennium; to authorize line item  
3 transfers for the 1999-2001 biennium; and to declare an emergency.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the  
6 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in  
7 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal  
8 funds and from other income, to the state historical society for the purpose of defraying the  
9 expenses of the state historical society, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending  
10 June 30, 2001, as follows:

21 **SECTION 2. LINE ITEM TRANSFERS - 1999-2001 BIENNIUM.** Notwithstanding  
22 section 54-16-04, the director of the office of management and budget and the state treasurer  
23 shall make transfers of funds between the capital improvements line item and the Lewis and

1 Clark bicentennial line item in section 1 of this Act as may be requested by the state historical  
2 board for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.

3 **SECTION 3. LINE ITEM TRANSFERS - 1997-99 BIENNIUM.** Notwithstanding section  
4 54-16-04, the director of the office of management and budget and the state treasurer, at the  
5 request of the superintendent of the state historical society, shall transfer \$34,886 from the  
6 equipment line item contained in subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 22 of the 1997 Session  
7 Laws to the operating expenses line item contained in subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 22  
8 of the 1997 Session Laws. The authority to make this transfer begins with the effective date of  
9 this Act and ends on June 30, 1999.

10 **SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION.** There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$4,900 of  
11 federal funds available to the state historical society for the purpose of purchasing equipment  
12 for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 1999.

13 **SECTION 5. EMERGENCY.** Sections 3 and 4 of this Act are declared to be an  
14 emergency measure.
