- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 37-01-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the power of the governor to order out the national guard.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 37-01-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 37-01-04. Governor may Governor's authority to order out national guard in case
- 7 **of insurrection or riot Reserve militia ordered out.** In case of insurrection, invasion,
- 8 tumult, riot, or breach of the peace, or imminent danger thereof, <u>or to provide a deterrent</u>
- 9 presence at state ceremonial events, the governor may order into the active service of this
- 10 state any part of the national guard that he the governor may deem proper. When the national
- 11 guard of this state, or a part thereof, is called forth under the Constitution of the United States
- 12 and the laws of the United States, the governor shall order out for service the remaining troops
- 13 or such part thereof as may be necessary. If the number of available troops is insufficient, the
- 14 governor shall order out such part of the reserve militia as he the governor may deem
- 15 necessary.
