- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 6-09-37 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to sale of land acquired by the Bank of North Dakota.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 6-09-37 of the 1997 Supplement to the North
Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 6-09-37. Sale and leasing of acquired agricultural real estate. The sale and leasing 7 of all agricultural real estate with an appraised value of ten thousand dollars or more acquired 8 by the Bank of North Dakota through foreclosure or deed in lieu of foreclosure must be done in 9 accordance with chapter 15-07 or 15-09 and rules of the board of university and school lands. 10 The sale and leasing of agricultural real estate with an appraised value of less than ten 11 thousand dollars, acquired by the Bank of North Dakota through foreclosure or deed in lieu of 12 foreclosure, may be done in a manner as the Bank determines is appropriate given the 13 circumstances. However, the Bank of North Dakota shall send notice of the proposed sale or 14 lease of agricultural real estate with an appraised value of less than ten thousand dollars to the 15 adjacent landowners by registered mail twenty days before the execution of the sale or lease 16 documents. In the case of a lease by the party holding the right of redemption, that party has 17 the right to purchase at any time.
