1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study grain credit-sale contracts to

2 determine the need to provide protection for farmers against grain warehouse and grain buyer

- 3 insolvency.
- 4 WHEREAS, state law does not require bond coverage to protect farmers in grain

5 warehouse and grain buyer insolvency proceedings if the grain was sold via credit-sale; and

6 WHEREAS, the use of various forms of credit-sale contracts has risen dramatically in
7 recent years; and

8 **WHEREAS**, this situation has greatly increased the risk exposure of farmers;

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 10 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

11 That the Legislative Council study grain credit-sale contracts to determine the need to 12 provide protection for farmers against grain warehouse and grain buyer insolvency; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
