- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 16.1-08.1-02 and 16.1-08.1-03.2 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to the filing of campaign contribution statements by political
- 3 committees organized in support of candidates.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-08.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

16.1-08.1-02. Contributions statement required of candidates <u>and political</u> <u>committees organized in support of candidates</u>. Any candidate who is soliciting or accepting contributions for any political purpose <u>and any political committee organized in</u> support of a candidate shall make and file a statement in accordance with this section.

The candidate <u>or political committee</u> shall include in the statement the name and mailing address of all contributors who contributed in excess of one hundred dollars in the aggregate during the reporting period to the candidate <u>or political committee</u>, the amount of each reportable contribution, and the date each reportable contribution was received.

The candidate <u>or political committee</u> shall file the statement no later than the twelfth day before the date of the election in which the candidate's name appears on the ballot or in which the candidate seeks election through write-in votes complete from the beginning of that calendar year through the twentieth day before the date of the election. The candidate <u>or political committee</u> shall file a complete statement for the entire calendar year no later than the thirty-first day of January of the following year, regardless of whether the candidate's name appeared on the ballot for any office during that calendar year or whether the candidate did not seek election at any election through write-in votes.

Statements of <u>for</u> a legislative candidate must be filed in the office of the county auditor of the candidate's county of residence. Statements of <u>for</u> state office candidates must be filed in the office of the secretary of state.

Even if the candidate <u>or political committee</u> has not received any contributions in excess of one hundred dollars during the calendar year, the candidate <u>or political committee</u> shall file a statement as required by this chapter.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-08.1-03.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

16.1-08.1-03.2. Political committee registration. A political committee, other than a political party and a committee organized in support of a legislative candidate, and a person aiding or opposing a measure to be voted upon by the voters of the state shall register its name, address, and its agent's name and address with the secretary of state each calendar year in which it receives any contribution. The registration must be completed within five days of the receipt of any contribution and must be submitted with a registration fee of five dollars.
