- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 16.1-05-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the qualifications of members of the board of election.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 16.1-05-02 of the North Dakota 5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 6 1. Every Except as provided in subdivision b, every member of the election 7 board and each poll clerk must be a qualified elector of the precinct in which 8 the person is assigned to work and must be eligible to vote at the polling place 9 to which the person is assigned unless the county auditor has exhausted all 10 means to appoint election judges and clerks from within the voting precinct 11 under subsection 2 of section 16.1-05-01. 12 A student enrolled in a high school or college in this state who has attained b. 13 the age of sixteen is eligible to be appointed as a poll clerk if the student 14 possesses the following qualifications: 15 (1) Is a United States citizen or will be a citizen at the time of the election at 16 which the student will be serving as a member of an election board; 17 (2) Is a resident of this state and has resided in the precinct at least thirty 18 days before the election; and 19 (3) Is a student in good standing attending a public or private secondary or 20 higher education institution. 21 A student appointed as a poll clerk must be excused from school attendance C. 22 during the hours that the student is serving as a poll clerk, including training 23 sessions, if the student submits a written request signed and approved by the

student's parent or guardian to be absent from school and a certification from

1	the district party chairman or county auditor stating the hours during which the
2	student will serve. A student excused from school attendance under this
3	subdivision may not be recorded as being absent on any date for which the
4	excuse is operative nor may the student be penalized by the school in any
5	manner. No more than two students may serve as poll clerks on an election
6	board.
