- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12.1-21 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to interference with a telephone during emergency calls.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 12.1-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 created and enacted as follows:

6 Interference with telephone during emergency call. A person is guilty of an offense 7 if that person removes, damages, or obstructs any telephone or telephone line or any part or 8 apparatus on the line, or severs any wire connected to the line, so as to interfere with an 9 emergency telephone call. The offense is a class C felony if it was done intentionally. The 10 offense is a class A misdemeanor if it was done knowingly or recklessly.
