SENATE BILL NO. 2335 (Senators Lee, Freborg, C. Nelson) (Representatives Koppang, L. Thoreson)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 15-41.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the postsecondary enrollment options program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-41.1-01 of the 1997 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

15-41.1-01. Postsecondary enrollment options program. Any North Dakota student enrolled in grade eleven or twelve in a public high school is eligible to receive high school and postsecondary credit for the successful completion of an <u>a postsecondary level</u> academic course offered by any postsecondary institution accredited by a regional accrediting organization or a <u>postsecondary level</u> vocational course offered by a postsecondary institution in a program accredited by a national or regional accrediting organization recognized by the United States department of education, provided the course is taught by a faculty member of the postsecondary institution.
