- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-21-39 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to tinted windows of motor vehicles.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-21-39 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - 39-21-39. Windshield Must be unobstructed and equipped with wipers Tinted windows.
    - Every motor vehicle must be equipped with a windshield. No person may drive
      any motor vehicle with any sign, poster, or other nontransparent material upon the
      front windshield, side wings, or side or rear windows which obstructs the driver's
      clear view of the highway or any intersecting highway.
    - 2. The windshield on every motor vehicle must be equipped with a device for cleaning rain, snow, or other moisture from the windshield, which must be so constructed as to be controlled or operated by the driver of the vehicle.
    - Every windshield wiper upon a motor vehicle must be maintained in good working order.
    - 4. A person may not operate a motor vehicle with any object, material, or tinting displayed, affixed, or applied en to the front windshield er except a strip across the top which does not extend downward more than six inches [15.24 centimeters]. A person may not operate a motor vehicle with any window unless the object, material, or tinting in conjunction with the window or windshield upon which it is displayed, affixed, or applied has a on the front side windows adjacent to the front seat driver and passenger except tinting that, when used in conjunction with the window glass, does not have a total reflectance in excess of twenty percent and

1	has a total light transmittance of at least seventy thirty-five percent. This
2	subsection does not apply to windows behind the operator if the motor vehicle is
3	equipped with outside mirrors on both sides that meet the requirements of section
4	39-21-38, nor to front side windows displaying transparent sunscreening material
5	as authorized by competent medical authority.
