## ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1410

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 20.1-03-07, section
- 2 20.1-03-07.1, and subsections 2, 7, 8, 37, 38, and 39 of section 20.1-03-12, relating to
- 3 nonresident hunting and fishing licenses and fees; and to provide an effective date.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 20.1-03-07 of the 1997
- 6 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 1. Hunt, catch, take, or kill any small game without a nonresident small game license.
- 8 <u>A nonresident small game license is not required to hunt waterfowl under section</u>
- 9 <u>20.1-03-07.1.</u>
- 10 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-03-07.1 of the 1997 Supplement to the
- 11 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 12 **20.1-03-07.1. Nonresident waterfowl hunting license required.** Except as provided
- in section 20.1-03-07.2, a nonresident may not hunt waterfowl unless that person first obtains a
- 14 nonresident waterfowl hunting license, in addition to a nonresident small game hunting license.
- 15 The nonresident waterfowl hunting license entitles the nonresident to hunt waterfowl for any
- 16 period of fourteen consecutive days or any two periods of seven consecutive days each and in
- 17 specified waterfowl hunting zones. A license authorizing two 7-day hunting periods may allow
- 18 hunting in a different zone during each period. The governor, in the governor's proclamation,
- 19 shall specify various waterfowl hunting zones for which nonresident waterfowl hunting licenses
- 20 will be available, and may specify the number of licenses which may be issued in each zone
- 21 and the manner in which they are to be issued. A nonresident is entitled to purchase only one
- 22 nonresident waterfowl hunting license per year.

- 1 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Subsections 2, 7, 8, 37, 38, and 39 of section 20.1-03-12
- 2 of the 1997 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code are amended and reenacted as
- 3 follows:
- 4 2. For a nonresident small game hunting license, seventy-five one hundred dollars.
- 5 7. For a nonresident fishing license, twenty-five thirty-two dollars.
- 8. For a nonresident short-term seven-day fishing license, fifteen twenty dollars.
- 7 37. For a nonresident waterfowl hunting license, ten seventy-five dollars.
- 8 38. For a nonresident husband and wife fishing license, thirty-five forty-two dollars.
- 9 39. For a nonresident short-term three-day fishing license, ten fifteen dollars.
- 10 **SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act becomes effective on April 1, 2000.
