1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to requirements for guides or outfitters; and to amend and reenact
3 subsection 14 of section 20.1-01-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to guides and
4 outfitters.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 14 of section 20.1-01-02 of the 1997
7 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

8 14. "Guide" or "outfitter" means any resident who ~~holds that person out to the public as~~
9 ~~a guide or outfitter, and who provides, for compensation, transportation,~~
10 ~~equipment, arrangement of lodging, or that person's own or another's personal~~
11 ~~services for the primary purpose of assisting a person or persons to locate or catch~~
12 ~~fish or to locate, pursue, or hunt small game, big game, or fur bearers for~~
13 ~~consideration provides a saddle or pack animal; facilities; camping equipment;~~
14 ~~vehicle, vessel, or other conveyance; or personal service for a person to hunt, trap,~~
15 ~~catch, take, kill, or pursue any game, including fish, and who accompanies that~~
16 ~~person, either part or all of the way on an expedition for any of these purposes. A~~
17 ~~person providing services on real property that the person owns or leases for the~~
18 ~~primary pursuit of bona fide agricultural interests is not a guide or outfitter.~~

19 Nonresidents are not entitled to act as guides or outfitters in this state.

20 **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is
21 created and enacted as follows:

22 **Guides and outfitters - Requirements.** An individual may not be issued a license to
23 guide without first providing the director:

- 1 1. Proof that the individual is covered by general liability insurance against loss or
2 expense due to accident or injury from guiding or outfitting services, at a minimum
3 of one hundred thousand dollars per individual and three hundred thousand dollars
4 per incident;
- 5 2. Proof that the individual is currently certified in adult cardiopulmonary resuscitation
6 or its equivalent; and
- 7 3. Proof that the individual is currently certified in standard first aid or its equivalent.
