3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 3 of section 26.1-41-13 of the North Dakota

 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 3. An insurer, health maintenance organization, or nonprofit health service corporation, other than a basic no-fault insurer, authorized to do business in this state may coordinate any benefits it that insurer, health maintenance organization, or health services corporation is obligated to pay for economic loss incurred as a result of accidental bodily injury, with the first five ten thousand dollars of basic no-fault benefits. A basic no-fault insurer authorized to do business in this state may coordinate any benefits it that insurer is obligated to pay for medical expenses incurred as a result of accidental bodily injury in excess of five ten thousand dollars. An insurer, health maintenance organization, or nonprofit health service corporation, other than a basic no fault insurer, may not coordinate benefits unless it that insurer, health maintenance organization, or nonprofit health service corporation provides those persons who purchase benefits from it that insurer, health maintenance organization, or nonprofit health service corporation with an equitable reduction or savings in the direct or indirect cost of purchased benefits. The commissioner shall approve any coordination of benefits plan.

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
