1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study basinwide water management 2 in the Red River Valley. 3 WHEREAS, the effective management of the state's water resources is essential to the 4 health, prosperity, and general welfare of the people of North Dakota; and 5 WHEREAS, most of the Red River Valley's existing water resource districts are based 6 upon political boundaries and not hydrologic boundaries; and 7 WHEREAS, rivers, streams, and watersheds in the Red River Valley do not correspond 8 with existing political boundaries; and 9 WHEREAS, the flood of 1997 caused a great deal of damage in communities 10 throughout the Red River Valley; and 11 WHEREAS, several proposals for basinwide water management that hold the promise 12 of reducing damage from future floods are being developed; and 13 WHEREAS, reduction in flood levels would significantly increase the safety and security 14 of conventional flood protection systems, such as dikes, that are being developed in the Red 15 River Valley; 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 17 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 18 That the Legislative Council study basinwide water management in the Red River 19 Valley; 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and 21 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 22 the Fifty-seventh legislative assembly.
