- A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability of establishing house subdistricts within senatorial districts when the legislative assembly redistricts after the 2000 census.

 WHEREAS, the Constitution of North Dakota requires the Legislative Assembly to
 - redistrict after each federal decennial census; and
 - WHEREAS, the Constitution of North Dakota allows for the election of house members from subdistricts or at large; and
- WHEREAS, the creation of subdistricts within senatorial districts may be particularly
 desirable in geographically large rural districts, but less desirable in more compact urban
 districts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

- That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of establishing house subdistricts within senatorial districts when the Legislative Assembly redistricts after the 2000 census; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly.
