## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3037

1 A concurrent resolution urging Congress to review the North American Free Trade Agreement  
2 and the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade and amend those portions of the agreements  
3 that treat North Dakota agricultural producers inequitably or repeal the agreements in their  
4 entirety.

5 **WHEREAS**, the North American Free Trade Agreement and the General Agreement on  
6 Tariffs and Trade have created international trade zones for agricultural products; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the North American Free Trade Agreement and the General Agreement on  
8 Tariffs and Trade were to have opened up expanded trade opportunities and vast new markets  
9 for our agricultural products; and

10 **WHEREAS**, neither the North American Free Trade Agreement nor the General  
11 Agreement on Tariffs and Trade have been able to stop the flood of agricultural products from  
12 other countries into the United States; and

13 **WHEREAS**, despite the existence of the North American Free Trade Agreement and  
14 the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade, North Dakota agricultural producers are  
15 experiencing income reductions and economic downturns similar to the farm crisis of the early  
16 1980s;

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**  
18 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

19 That the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly urges the Congress of the United States to  
20 review the North American Free Trade Agreement and the General Agreement on Tariffs and  
21 Trade and amend those portions of the agreements that treat North Dakota agricultural  
22 producers inequitably or repeal the agreements in their entirety; and

23 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this  
24 resolution to the Secretary of Agriculture, the chairmen of the Senate and House Agriculture  
25 Committees, and to each member of the North Dakota Congressional Delegation.
