

**HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3077**

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability  
2 of establishing and funding alternative high schools in rural areas.

3 **WHEREAS**, the number of students who would benefit from attending an alternative  
4 high school is increasing; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the Legislative Assembly has provided for the establishment and funding of  
6 alternative high school programs in this state; and

7 **WHEREAS**, alternative high school programs tend to be located in the more urban,  
8 populated school districts; and

9 **WHEREAS**, students in the rural, less populated areas of the state should also have the  
10 same opportunities to attend an alternative high school;

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**  
12 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

13 That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of establishing and  
14 funding alternative high schools in rural areas; and

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and  
16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to  
17 the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly.
