SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4052

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study options for holding regular

2 legislative sessions in even-numbered years.

WHEREAS, the session schedule of the Legislative Assembly should ensure the most
efficient and effective use of legislators' and the public's time and resources; and

5 WHEREAS, a different session structure could allow more efficiency in addressing
6 budget matters, in making better use of the interim process, in allowing more committee time for
7 bill processing, in providing more time for legislator orientation and training, and in providing

8 opportunities for leadership to develop agendas, budget alternatives, and support for major

9 legislation; and

WHEREAS, any study to consider changes to the scheduling of the legislative session
needs to include consideration of value of a citizen legislature and the need for enhanced
expertise and experience in dealing with increasingly difficult, complex issues, and an
increasing workload;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

16 That the Legislative Council study options for holding the regular legislative session in17 even-numbered years; and

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and

19 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to

20 the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly.
