- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the judicial branch;
- 2 to provide for a legislative council study; and to amend and reenact sections 27-02-02 and
- 3 27-05-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to salaries of supreme and district court
- 4 judges.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6	SECTION 4 ADDDODDIATION The	funda provided in this acction, or as much of the	
6		funds provided in this section, or so much of the	
7	funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in		
8	the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal		
9	funds and other income, to the judicial branch for the purpose of defraying the expenses of its		
10	various divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001, as

19	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There are hereby appropriated any funds received by		
20	the supreme court, district courts, and judicial conduct commission and disciplinary board, not		
21	otherwise appropriated, pursuant to federal acts and private gifts, grants, and donations for the		
22	purpose as designated in the federal acts or private gifts, grants, and donations for the period		
23	beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.		
24	SECTION 3. TRANSFERS. The director of the office of management and budget and		
25	the state treasurer shall make such transfers of funds between line items of appropriation for		
26	the judicial branch of government as may be requested by the supreme court upon a finding by		
27	the court that the nature of the duties of the court and its staff requires the transfers to carry on		
28	properly the functions of the judicial branch of government.		
29	SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY OF UNIFIED COURT SYSTEM. The		
30	legislative council shall consider studying, during the 1999-2000 int	erim, the impacts of court	

unification on the judicial system and on the effective provision of judicial services to state
residents.

shall develop criteria for the equitable allocation of indigent defense funds contained in the operating expenses line item for district courts. The criteria must be based on number of cases, complexity of cases, the level of efficiency in handling cases, and the historical funding levels in different districts. The supreme court may use any other factors deemed appropriate by the supreme court. The historical funding levels may be used as one factor of many and may not be given consideration in excess of any other factor. The supreme court shall use these criteria in the allocation of indigent defense funds appropriated under this Act.

SECTION 6. CLERK OF COURT UNIFICATION. Notwithstanding the provisions of 1999 House Bill No. 1275, the supreme court shall implement the clerk of court unification effective April 1, 2001.

SECTION 7. AMENDMENT. Section 27-02-02 of the 1997 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

27-02-02. Salaries of judges of supreme court. The annual salary of each judge of the supreme court is seventy-nine eighty-three thousand seven eight hundred seventy-one seven dollars through June 30, 1998 2000, and eighty-two eighty-five thousand one four hundred sixty four eighty-three dollars thereafter. The chief justice of the supreme court is entitled to receive an additional two thousand two three hundred fifty sixty-five dollars per annum through June 30, 1998 2000, and two thousand three four hundred eighteen twelve dollars per annum thereafter.

SECTION 8. AMENDMENT. Section 27-05-03 of the 1997 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

27-05-03. Salaries and expenses of district judges. The annual salary of each district judge is seventy-three seventy-seven thousand six three hundred sixteen forty dollars through June 30, 1998 2000, and seventy-five seventy-eight thousand eight hundred twenty four eighty-seven dollars thereafter. Each district judge is entitled to travel expenses including mileage and subsistence while engaged in the discharge of official duties outside the city in which the judge's chambers are located. The salary and expenses are payable monthly in the manner provided by law. A presiding judge of a judicial district is entitled to receive an

- 2 June 30, 1998 <u>2000</u>, and one thousand seven <u>eight</u> hundred ninety-five <u>sixty-eight</u> dollars
- 3 thereafter.
